Memorial Scholarship Grant

The AGSES Memorial Scholarship Grant is supported by monetary gifts given through the Tribute Fund. Memorial Scholarship Grants are awarded to AGSES members seeking to improve themselves professionally. Applicant information and amount of grants are confidential.

To ensure that all AGSES members have equal access to these funds, the following criteria will apply to all applicants:

- Applicant must have maintained AGSES membership for at least a total of 3 consecutive years.
- Applicant is eligible to receive a Memorial Scholarship Grant one time only.
- Applicant must submit a completed application at least three months prior to the educational/professional opportunity.
- Grants are allotted up to a maximum of \$400.
- A Memorial Scholarship Grant can only be used for external development. It does not cover expenses associated with AGSES meetings, AGSES national conventions or GSUSA meetings and learning opportunities.
